SURFACE PREPARATION

Designed for application over GN133UE. Before application of GN136UE, clean surface if any fouling or debris has settled on surface with abrasive discs. GN136UE can be applied by spatula.

Water temperature must be > 1°C (18°F).

GlobalDur GN136 Underwater Epoxy is a two pack product, so both components must be mixed on the right ratio. First, component A should be well mixed during 2 minutes. After that, add component B and stir very well until it get homogeneous. If over agitated, Pot Life will be reduced. High temperatures will reduce Pot Life and Low temperatures will increase Pot Life.
